Please take the time to read this important notice and distribute to all of your empowered officials.

Effective February 12, 2007, all D-Trade users must use their DDTC-approved registrant name before a license application or amendment will be accepted by the D-Trade system. The DDTC-approved name must be provided in the first line of the D-Trade request underneath "applicant type" in the block titled "Applicant's Name, Address, ZIP Code, Telephone Number" For a DSP-5 or DSP-73, that is block 5. For a DSP-61, that is block 8

Your DDTC registrant name is listed below along with your registration code and expiration date:

Please note that due to current computer character space limitations, the DDTC registrant name may be shorter than the name you generally use in D-Trade submissions or as reflected in official documentation (e.g., articles of incorporation). You may update or change this name upon registration renewal or you may notify this Office of a material change pursuant to Section 122.4 of the International Traffic in Arms Regulations (22 CFR 120-130). In the case of a name and/or address change you will be issued a new registration letter reflecting the revision. The expiration date will not change.

The requirement to use the DDTC-approved registrant name is part of a new D-Trade software security feature that will check the D-Trade request against DDTC's official registration records to confirm that the name submitted on the request matches our records. If a match is not

made, the D-Trade system will automatically reject a license application or amendment and preclude its submission to DDTC. This added feature will help prevent a third party from potential, improper use of a registrant's name, code and licensing privileges. The feature will provide an extra level of security for users and improve the integrity of the D-Trade system

Registrants should ensure that their empowered officials are aware of this new requirement and consult the DDIC website at www.pmdtc.state.gov for more information. DDTC will NOT provide the official registrant name or code over the phone or via e-mail to D-Trade users. In addition, the registrant code is unique to a registrant and should be protected.
